CLASS B – FIELD CROPS AND POTATOES

Note: ½ peck required on all threshed samples.

- Haylage – one 5 qt. plastic pail, with lid
- Corn on Stalk (3 stalks)
- Hybrid Corn (6 ears)
- Sweet corn, this year's (6 ears)
- Popcorn, Tom Thumb (6 ears)
- Any other corn variety, named on tag, not fitting in above classes (6 ears)
- Potatoes, early, 6 tubers, named on tag
- Potatoes, mid-season, 6 tubers, named on tag
- Potatoes, late, 6 tubers, named on tag

CLASS C – FRUIT

Any exhibitor may enter a maximum of 6 plates, but each must be a different variety. Each plate should contain 6 specimens, except Lots 15, 16, & 17.
