PLANTS

Judging: Thursday, 1:00 p.m. – Exhibition Hall

1. Specimens must be in a clear glass container – no labels (Ex: jelly, chili, pickle jars, etc.)
2. Flower specimens will be judged on size, shape, health and quality; not on container.
3. Arrangements will be judged on condition of materials, color, proportion and balance, and container.
4. During judging no discussion from audience about entries until lot has been placed.

CLASS A – ANNUALS – Specimens Only

Cut flowers must be in by noon on Thursday and must remain on exhibition until 7:00 p.m., Sunday. Each lot must contain **three (3) blooms only**.

 4. Single Petunias
 5. Double Petunias
 6. Marigolds, small
 7. Marigolds, large
 8. Snapdragons, short
 9. Snapdragons, tall
 10. Zinnias, dwarf

 12. Any other annual – labeled on tag
- CLASS B – PERENNIALS – Specimens Only**
1. Coneflowers – 3 blooms
 2. Coreopsis – 3 blooms
 3. Rose – one bloom
 4. Roses – 3 blooms
 5. Rudbeckia Daisies – 3 blooms
- CLASS C - FLOWERS FROM BULBS - Specimens Only**
1. Caladium – one bloom
 2. Dahlias, small – one bloom
 3. Dahlias, large – one bloom
 4. Dahlias, assorted – 3 blooms
 5. Gladiola – one bloom
 6. Gladiola – 3 blooms
 7. Daylilies – 3 blooms
 8. Oriental Lilies –fragrant (Ex: Casablanca, Stargazer) – 3 blooms
 9. Any other Lily – one variety (Tiger, Asiatic, Trumpet, etc.) – 3 blooms named on tag

CLASS D - ARRANGEMENTS

1. Basket of Perennials – NO annuals
2. Salute to Green County – “Just Say Cheese” arrangement using flowers in “cheese” colors. Accessories permitted.
3. All green arrangement – including container

4. All white arrangement – including container
5. Flower arrangement for grandma
6. Miniature arrangement – under 6”
7. “Side of the Road” arrangement
8. Arrangement in Red, White & Blue
9. Arrangement for kitchen
10. Arrangement in a junk container



CLASS E – POTTED PLANTS

Plants must be in place between 12:00 noon and 5:00 p.m., Wednesday and remain on exhibition until 7:00 p.m. on Sunday.

1. Plants are to be started after September 1 of previous exhibit year.
2. Potted plants must be grown in pots by exhibitor.
3. Plants are not to be purchased for exhibit.

1. Foliage plant (single plant)
2. Geranium (single plant)
3. Any Begonia (single plant)
4. Any Impatient (single plant)
5. African violet (single plant – single flower)
6. African violet (single plant – double flower)

8. Coleus
9. Indoor dish garden – planter (3 or more green plants, cactus, etc. potted)
10. Terrarium
11. Outdoor planted container – (3 or more plants potted)
