CLASS D – FRUIT

Lot

1. Exhibit of small ripe fruit grown by member – 1 variety, fresh – displayed in pint box. Examples – raspberries, strawberries. Cover tightly with plastic wrap.
2. Exhibit of ripe or green apples grown by member. Display 6 apples, all one variety, on plate
3. Exhibit of ripe or green tree fruit (other than apples) grown by member – 6, all one variety displayed on plate (examples – pears, plums) or pint box of small tree fruit such as cherries.
4. A series of posters, or a display, showing steps followed in completing the necessary jobs of fruit culture. This includes such jobs as: planting, cultivation, fertilization, pruning, spraying, mulching, harvesting, etc. This series should follow a specific fruit from planting through production.
