6. Put name, age, club, class and lot number on back side of every entry.
7. Participants receive ribbons **ONLY**.
8. Members can enter up to 4 lots.
9. All projects are to be brought in between Noon and 7:00 p.m. on Tuesday and cannot be removed until after 7:00 p.m. on Sunday.

CLASS A – ANIMAL SCIENCE

Lot

1. Create a critter
2. Display or poster about insect(s)
3. Scrapbook or memory book about your pet
4. Any other pet exhibit (no live animals)
5. Bird Feeder
6. Bird house
7. Craft that is animal related
8. Any other animal exhibit (No Live Animals)

CLASS B – EXPRESSIVE ARTS

Lot

1. Musical instrument made by exhibitor
2. Scrapbook of photos done by member (with captions/journaling)
3. Puppet made by exhibitor
4. T-shirt decorated by exhibitor (on hanger)
5. Any other wearable art project
6. Small wood item
7. Any craft item (kits can be used; i.e. latchhook, stitchery, etc.)
8. Item of art from a kit (i.e. Paint by number, scratch art, etc.)
