Photography Rules and Instructions

**PLEASE READ THESE.**

1. Fair Association is not responsible for articles lost/stolen during fair.
2. Photography exhibits must be result of the exhibitor's project work. Pictures are to have been taken after 1<sup>st</sup> day of the previous fair.
3. Exhibitors must exhibit in their grade division. Limit of 4 entries.
4. Any 1 or 2 picture exhibit 5x7 or smaller **MUST** be exhibited on an 8"x10" poster or we will ask to have it cut down due to space limitations. All other exhibits must be on 11"x14" poster board and securely mount photos with **rubber cement or scrapbooking glue** rather than glue. Posters must be on **white or black poster board only** – no other colors allowed. No foam core boards or matted boards please. **No titles or captions will be allowed.** List type of camera on the back of each poster and also place name & club on back - bottom of poster please.
5. **NO MATTING WILL BE ALLOWED.** No picture frames or hangers. Cropping is encouraged and must be used if the number of required photographs will not fit on the poster board sizes listed above. Cropping is limited to square and rectangular shapes. It is **suggested that** NO dates are listed on the front of the photograph.
6. **No borders, outlining or decorating of photos or poster board is allowed – display your photos only.**
7. **You may not exhibit the same photograph in more than one lot number.**
8. Photos will be judged on the basis of technical quality, composition, and story-telling ability.
9. Winning photos entered in the "3 prints promoting tourism in Green County" become the property of the Green County Tourism Committee.
10. Please try to leave an area for the Exhibitor's tag to be placed at the top left corner of poster.
