### Woodworking Rules and Instructions

1. Fair Association is not responsible for articles lost/stolen during fair.
2. Member must exhibit in Unit in which they are enrolled, including shop class entries.
3. No exhibitor is allowed more than four entries.
4. Work must have been made since September 1 of last year.
5. All articles are to be finished according to their intended use. The quality of the finish will be considered as part of the workmanship in judging.
6. An article made for class work and for a grade or extra credit must be entered in the class so designated.
7. No kits or mass production items to be used.
8. Members may wish to attach a card explaining an exhibit.
9. Hangable projects must have applicable hangers for their intended use.
