2. No member can enter more than 4 classes.
3. Clothing **MUST** be modeled by the person for whom it was made.
4. Garments made for Style Revue may NOT also be entered in the clothing classes at the fair.
5. All participants are required to participate in a mini-revue during the green County Fair.
6. State Delegates – Two members from among the top exhibitors will be selected to represent Green County at the Wisconsin Junior State Fair. To qualify members must be between the ages of 14 and 19, an of January 1, of the current year. Members may not represent the county two years in succession. Clothes made in college class are not eligible for State Fair Clothing Revue.
7. Style revue garments will be judged on the following:
 - I. The Costume and the Member
 - a. Style of costume
 - b. Becoming color
 - c. Appropriateness of fabric
 - d. Selection of undergarments
 - e. Selection of accessories
 - f. Fit
 - II. The Costume Itself
 - a. Appropriateness of trimmings
 - b. Selection and quality of construction method
 - c. Present condition of costume
 - d. Upkeep in relation to costume value
 - III. The Member
 - a. Posture
 - b. Poise
 - c. Grooming
