Home Furnishings Rules and Instructions

1. Fair Association is not responsible for articles lost/stolen.
2. No more than 4 entries may be made by one exhibitor.
3. **All entries must be accompanied by a note card containing a brief statement that includes:**
 - a. **a description of the room or area where the entry**
 - b. **will be used**
 - c. **a description of the work done on the entry**
 - d. **a description of intended use in the home**
4. Include (secure) hangers if item is to be hung, pictures
5. should be framed.
6. Quilts include tied, hand-quilted, machine quilted professionally or home sewing machine.
7. All quilted wall hangings should include a picture or description of how they will be used at home. Bring item with dowel rod for use in hanging.
