1. Exhibitors must be enrolled in the youth Leadership project
2. There is no limit to the numbers entries in each age group.
3. Posters should be 14"x22" or 28"x22".
4. A display may be a mobile, model, photos, outline, chart, guide, actual articles, posters, scrapbook or a combination of display methods. See Youth Leadership project manuals for ideas and examples.

Open to members Grades 9 and up

17. A display and explanation showing leadership contributions to a district, county, or state event
18. A report on what you would like to see added or changed in 4-H. Give your age and years as a club member.
19. Display about the characteristics of good teamwork
20. Display on leadership styles
21. Photo story of a leadership experience
22. Display of a community service-learning project you helped plan
23. Portfolio of your leadership experiences
24. Any other project showing a leadership activity

Adult/Junior Leaders

In order to be eligible for adult leader tickets, leaders must be involved in active clubs that have been organized for at least four months. Fill out your fair entry form and return to your general leader, so all leaders forms can be turned in at the same time members forms are turned in. No late entries will be accepted.

PLEASE NOTE: If you are working as a superintendent or are exhibiting at the fair you **should not enter** a leadership lot. Once entries are received there will be no entry fee refunds.

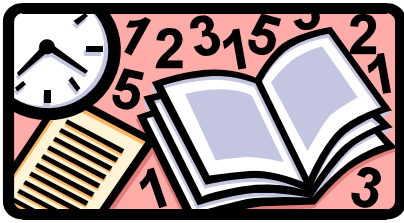
CLASS B – SELF DETERMINED

CLASS C – ENTREPRENEURSHIP

Entrepreneurship Rules and Instructions

1. Exhibitors must be enrolled in the Entrepreneurship Project.
2. Only one entry per lot.
3. A display may be a mobile, model, photos, outline, chart, guide, articles, posters, scrapbook or a combination of display methods.
4. A profile includes interviews and research on a specific business or entrepreneur. Profiles should be presented in a display format.
5. An advertisement must be designed by the exhibitor. It can include a print out of a website, a newspaper advertisement, flyer, brochure or other creative advertising format. (ie. magnet, pen, etc.)
6. A set of business materials should include a business card, letterhead, and any other communication item (ie. envelope, postcard) displaying a business logo designed by the exhibitor.

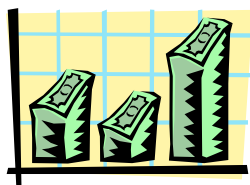
