Breeding Goat Age Classification

- a. Junior Dairy Doe Kid, born March 15 and later of current year.
- b. Senior Dairy Doe Kid, born January 1 to March 14 of current year.
- c. Junior Dairy Yearling Doe, born August 1 to December 31 of prior year.
- d. Senior Dairy Yearling Doe, at least 12 month but under 24 months of age and not in milk.
- e. Junior Meat Type Doe Kid, born March 15 and later of current year
- f. Senior Meat Type Doe Kid, born January 1 to March 14 of current year
- g. Yearling Dairy Milker, under 2 years of age and in milk.
- h. Junior Dairy Milker, at least 2 years but under 3 years of age.
- i. Mature Dairy Milker, at least 3 years but under 5 years of age.
- j. Aged Dairy Milker, 5 years of age and older.
- k. Yearling Meat Type Doe, under 2 years of age and has freshened
- l. Mature Meat Type Doe, over 2 years of age and has freshened

Goat Rules and Instructions

1. Age of animal for determining the appropriate class shall be computed from the opening day of the fair, unless otherwise specified.
2. Intact males may not be entered.
3. All breeding and market goats exhibited at the Green County Fair must be identified in one of two ways: a legible tattoo with accompanying registration papers from a recognized breed association; or a USDA Scrapie Flock Identification tag placed in their ear PRIOR to entering the fairgrounds.
4. All goats must be fitted with a restraint collar while on the fairgrounds.

Market Lot Rules and Instructions

1. Only exhibitors who are members of a Green county 4-H club or FFA chapter and/or reside in Green County are eligible to exhibit in the Green County Fair Junior Market Wether Show.
2. All market wether entries must be weighed on Wednesday, at 5:00 p.m. There will be no repeat weights.
3. Market animals should be entered in Lots 1-4.
4. Market wether class entries must be castrated.

CLASS B – MARKET LOTS

Lot

1. Junior Market Wether, Dairy Type, born after February 1st of current year
2. Junior Market Wether, Meat Type, born after February 1st of current year
3. Senior Market Wether, Dairy Type, born after November 1 of prior year to January 31 of current year
4. Senior Market Wether, Meat Type, born after November 1 of prior year to January 31 of current year

CLASS C – SHOWMANSHIP (Danish Judging)

Exhibitors must enter this class on their official entry blank in order to compete. Grade as of January 1 of exhibit year.
