**Poultry Rules and Instructions**

1. Fair Assn is not responsible for birds lost, stolen or that die.
  2. Each exhibitor allowed 1 entry per Lot, total of not more than 7 Lots. (Showmanship does not count toward your Lot total)
  3. Each exhibitor must take care of his own exhibit(s).  
**Birds not taken care of daily may be sent home and the member will forfeit the premium money on the exhibit(s).**
  4. All cockerels/pullets entered in Class A must have be hatched after January 1<sup>st</sup> of the exhibit year.
  5. Exhibitors should use some form of identification for birds.
  6. Exhibitors must be present during all judging.
  7. Exhibits MUST be in place by 5:00 p.m. on Wednesday.
  8. All exhibitors are required to clean their cages prior to leaving the fairgrounds on Sunday evening.

**Age Classification**

**Cock:** Hatched before January 1 of the exhibit year  
**Cockerel:** Hatched January 1 or after of exhibit year  
**Hen:** Hatched before January 1 of exhibit year  
**Pullet:** Hatched January 1 or after of exhibit year  
**Breed:** A group of birds of similar shape and size  
**Variety:** The various plumage colors and comb types within a breed

**Poultry Rules and Instructions**

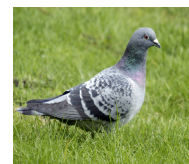
1. Roasters (Lot 1), Ducks (Lot 3) & Turkeys (Lot 4) will be weighed at 5:30 p.m. on Wednesday, following the rabbit weigh-in.

**Lot**

1. Roasters (2 birds, either sex)
2. Yearling laying hen (Judged on egg production. Exhibitor must bring eggs collected from the yearling hen, from the past 7 days to be judged. Eggs are to be brought in and taken home on show day only!)
3. Best pair of ducks (one male, one female)
4. Best pair of turkeys (Hens only)
2. Any crossbred meat type (red ear lobe single)

**CLASS C – PIGEONS**

1. Any fancy male
2. Any fancy female
3. Any other male
4. Any other female
